Clinic Provides Free Immunizations

The Woodlands, TX (Monday, April 18, 2011) – On Wednesday, April 13, 2011, 18 children received free immunizations at the Interfaith Community Clinic as part of the Care Van Immunization Clinic hosted by BlueCross BlueShield of Texas.
